UPCOMING ROAD PAVING & REPAIR PROJECTS

Mayor Palmer and the Adamsville City Council approved the following roads for paving: Waverly Avenue (\$44,504.18); Russell Drive (\$10,225.25); Tundridge Circle (\$41,825.85). Major repairs were also approved for the following roadways: Waverly Avenue drainage ditches/culvert repairs (\$16,500) and Longview Drive shoulder repair (\$5,129.25). Waverly Ave. repairs have already begun, and the rest of these projects should begin

within a couple weeks. Please make sure that you don't leave any vehicles parked on or close to the roadways where paving and/or repairs will occur.
